



PRACTICAL CONFIGURATION MANAGEMENT (PCM01)

The requirements of CM are as diverse as are the requirements of each product. Whether your product is a service or designing, producing and maintaining a state-of-the-art software or hardware, the basic principles of CM are applicable to keep changes under control. This course is based on the requirements of ISO 10007 and ANSA/EIA649.

Course Objectives:

Firstly, to promote an understanding of the principles applicable to CM and secondly, to provide solutions to problems. In this way learners learn how to apply the concepts within their own organisation. This course deals with the functions of identification, control, status accounting and audits. The configuration management plan is dealt with in a separate course (CMP01). Configuration audits are also handled in more depth in a separate course (CMA01).
